

Matthew Shampine currently serves as General Manager of South Korea where he manages WeWork's operations, community and sales. His responsibilities include growing the team and location portfolio, developing partnerships and growth opportunities, and ensuring the continuity of WeWork's unique culture, product and community across the country.

Before assuming this role, Shampine served as Head of Marketing and Revenue in Asia, where he opened new markets such as Korea, China, Hong Kong and Australia and lead marketing and sales throughout the region. Prior to moving to Asia, he focused on expanding WeWork's service and partnership platform as VP of Business Development. Additionally, Shampine co-founded WeWork Labs in 2011, WeWork's incubator for early-stage companies that has supported thousands of early-stage entrepreneurs.

Shampine initially joined WeWork as a founding member at the company's first location in 2010 with a digital agency that he co-founded, Simande. Shampine also co-founded Onepager, an investor backed growth platform for small businesses, and We Are NY Tech, an online editorial sharing the stories of hundreds of New York City based startup founders. Prior to entering the startup world, he was a Senior Web Developer at Mercedes-Benz USA and ran for public office in New Jersey in 2007.

Shampine recently served as an advisor to Entrepreneurs Roundtable Accelerator, an early stage technology accelerator based in NYC, and the non-profit KSE (Korean Startups & Entrepreneurs) organized to catalyze Korean and Korean-American entrepreneurship through community and resources. He is an active angel investor and advisor to a number of successful startups in both Korea and the United States. Shampine was born in South Korea and adopted
