JC SONG as a program director for solar PV at KETEP has lead the government supported R&D programs with the Ministry of Trade, Industry & Energy(MOTIE) since 2015, after his 25 years career at Hanwha.

As a vice CTO at Corporate R&D Center, managing director of polysilicon division and senior VP of solar energy business of Hanwha Chemical Corp., he had contributed in the creation of the initiatives on Hanwha Q-Cells to stand as one of the world's most competitive and sustainable entities in the solar PV industry. He was awarded the Order of Industrial Merit(Bronze Tower) in 2013.

JC has over 20 years of various experiences in plant operation, R&D, business development and engineering as well as M&A at Hanwha.
