Dr Sneh Khemka is President of Population Health at Aetna International. In this role, he is responsible for running businesses across the world – all associated with healthcare IT, data analytics and care provision. Previously, Sneh was Chief Operating Officer for Advanced Oncotherapy PLC, which is involved in advanced proton therapy, and is a spin off from CERN (home of the Large Hadron Collider)

He also works as an expedition medic, supporting people undertaking challenges around the world.

Sneh has previously advised and acted for a number of private equity houses in the UK and Europe. He is also a non-executive director of Viapath, the largest UK pathology company; and

previously NED for the Joint Commission International, the US-based leading hospital accreditation authority. In 2013, Sneh was awarded an honorary Membership to the Faculty of Public Health in recognition of his contributions to the field.
