Ihn Yohan is a member of 22nd National Assembly of South Korea, serving on the Foreign Affairs and Unification Committee. After the party's by-election loss in October, he was appointed head of the People Power Party's Innovation Committee, where he led key reform initiatives.

Ihn, the grandson of Dr. William Linton, who served as the personal physician to independence leader Kim Koo, followed in his grandfather's footsteps by becoming a family medicine specialist and dedicating his career to healthcare. In recognition of his humanitarian aid for North Koreans and his contributions to South Korea's medical system, including the development of the Korean-style ambulance, he was granted special naturalization in 2012. Ihn was a professor in the Department of Family Medicine at Yonsei University's Severance Hospital and served as the

Chairman of the hospital's International Health Care Center.

Ihn holds a Bachelor's degree in Medicine from Yonsei University and a Master's and Ph.D. in Medicine from Korea University, and he completed his family medicine residency in the United States.
